Our local guide will be delighted to show you the capital, San Salvador, and share insights into the country's history, culture, and people. We begin by visiting San Salvador's Historic Center, including the cathedral and the Mausoleum of Monsignor Romero, followed by a panoramic tour of modern areas, such as the National Library and the city's new neighborhoods. Free time for lunch (meals not included). After lunch, we will visit El Boquerón National Park, located at the summit of the San Salvador Volcano. Duration: 8 hours.

Located 30 minutes from San Salvador is the Joya de Cerén Archaeological Site—a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring a Maya village buried by ash from a nearby volcanic eruption. Next, we visit the San Andrés Archaeological Site, an ancient political and ceremonial center featuring pyramids. We also visit the Tazumal Ceremonial Site, home to the tallest pyramid in El Salvador. Free time for lunch (not included). Afterward, we stop for lunch with a view of Lake Coatepeque (lunch not included) before returning to the hotel.
